











# NRPS Dundee Award

## Qualifications:

A CANDIDATE MUST MEET ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

-  The candidate must be a member of NRPS. The Dundee Award is the highest award given by NRPS, and it behooves the Awards Committee to keep this in mind when considering candidates.
-  *Preparation:* At least a Bachelor's degree.
-  *Longevity:* Twenty-five years of active service to NRPS.
-  Contributions should be rendered primarily through the NRPS to the general field of parks and/or recreation.
-  At a minimum, one-term as President of NRPS.
-  Served on the NRPS Executive Board as an officer at least three terms other than as President.
-  Served at least five years as Committee Chair in the NRPS.
-  Committee Chair in the NRPA organization at either the national, regional, branch, or section level.
-  Substantial contribution, other than the above, to the profession on a regional and/or national level.
-  Fine moral character.
