




NRPS Fellowship Award

Qualifications:

 The candidate must be a member of NRPS. The Fellowship Award is one of the highest awards given by NRPS, and it behooves the Awards Committee to keep this in mind when considering candidates.

 *Preparation:* At least a Bachelor's degree, or equivalent in study.

 *Experience:* At least ten years experience in the general field of parks and/or recreation, in the State of Nevada.

 *Service:* Contributions should be rendered primarily through the NRPS to the general field of parks and/or recreation, and contribution should be in the nature of PLUS SERVICE.

 A CANDIDATE MUST MEET AT LEAST FIVE OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- An office holder in NRPS.
- President of NRPS.
- Committee Chair of a national park and/or recreation organization or branch.
- Outstanding leadership in some special field connected with parks and/or recreation.
- Committee-work over a period of three or more years with a local, region, state, or national organization, either in NRPS or affiliated with it.
- Fifteen or more presentations before recreation groups, conventions, assemblies, luncheon meetings, radio presentations, and other such gatherings held in the promotion of Parks and/or Recreation.
- Contributing articles for handbooks, newspapers, and magazines in the interest of parks and/or recreation.
- Carrying on research problems to help promote the profession.
- Author or co-author of one or more books on parks and/or recreation.
- Author of five or more articles accepted and published by magazines of national scope.
